**NAME:** Middle School Math Team

**DESCRIPTION:** This team is for students who want more challenge in math. The main focus is math competition. The team participates in seven different types of math contests or meets during the year. We work on helping students not only prepare for competitions, but also learn from each one afterwards by discussing the correct answers and how to solve the problems. Students should be open to improvement and learning more about problem solving and competition skills in the process.

New this year, Math Team will be split into a Varsity and Junior Varsity group, with eligibility guidelines listed below.

### ELIGIBILITY:

- Varsity - 7th/8th grade *and* a returning Math Team member *and* good attendance record in previous Math Team season
- Junior Varsity - 5th-8th grade *and* must be in Algebra I or higher math class
- 5th/6th graders may be eligible to attend the IMSA meet (based on availability)
- 8th grade Varsity team members will be given preference over 8th grade JV team members to attend the Latin School Meet

### MEETING DETAILS:

- Meets throughout school year
- Day - Friday
- Time - After school for 90 minutes
- Frequency - 1x a week
- Plus occasional weekend competitions throughout the year
- Additional practice times may be scheduled depending on faculty/volunteer and student availability
