ELIGIBILITY:

- 5th - 8th grade, by invitation only
- Tryouts held at the beginning of the school year

MEETING DETAILS:

- Meets throughout school year
- Day - Tue/Wed/Thu, depending on event
- Time - After school for two, 45-minute practice blocks (some events practice immediately after school, others during the second practice block)
- Frequency - 1-3x a week depending on number of events
- Plus various weekend competitions throughout the year
