TITLE: Elementary Science Olympiad (ESO)

ELIGIBILITY: 3rd - 4th grade, by invitation only. ESO participants must have a strong interest in science and Science Olympiad, and be prepared to make a serious commitment to the program.

DESCRIPTION: ESO is a standards based STEM program that encourages students to find their passion in science. The program incorporates hands-on activities combined with traditional learning methods. ESO makes an excellent segue for students who decide to pursue the middle school division of Science Olympiad in the future.
